The campground is right on the Colorado River with boating, fishing and swimming (Brrr). Some tour companies offer boat tours to scenic canyons on the river or to London Bridge and back in Lake Havasu City. Visit Davis Dam and Marina just a few miles away.

Laughlin casinos are nearby with low cost buffets and entertainment. You can drive across the bridge to the casinos or take a water taxi across the river.

Oatman, AZ is a short drive away on Historic Route 66. This was a gold mining town, now a ghost town, with lots of touristy things, such as wild burros roaming the streets and old saloons offering lunch and drinks. They even have a make believe shootout from time to time! We will schedule a caravan to Oatman on Wednesday or Thursday.
