Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday, January 22nd through the 24th

You are welcome to arrive early or stay longer. BLM camping is free for up to 14 days.

Our camping site will be the same location as it was last year, at Mile Marker 99 on Highway 95, just south of town. The turnoff is N 33.580. W 114.218. Turn right onto 53rd Street North (aka **La Paz Valley Road**). Approximate campsite is N 33.585. W 114.223. **Our talk in frequency is 147.510 MHz.**
