How to remove a photo's background & select the subject

**iPhone must have updated software iOS 16 or higher.*

**If Live Photo was used to take the photo it must be turned off.*

1. Using a clear photo of a subject, long press on the subject.
2. You will see the subject get highlighted briefly and a menu will pop up saying "Copy | Share..."



3. Select "Copy"
You can now paste that subject into any App on your phone by just tapping in the text field, like in Messages, Notes or into an email.
4. Select "Share..."
You can now Share the subject via AirDrop or save it as a new photo in your photo library.

This process also works with a subject in a video.
